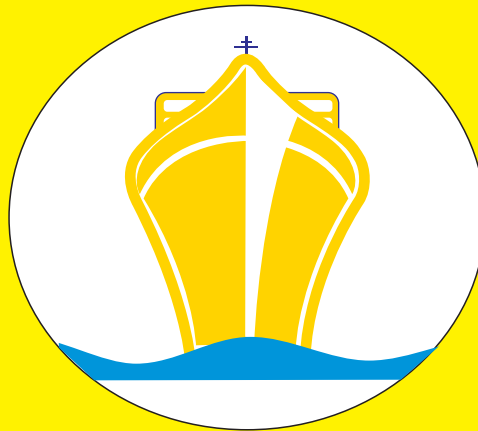

- A long-standing contract of carriage having become uncompetitive, may make re-negotiation an attractive option.
- An operator may be in dispute with an authority over a concessionaire's performance.
- Or with a supplier over the quality of a product or support services.
- Or an accident may have taken place.
